

COCKROACH AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS

- 2. Food Storage: Seal all food in plastic, airtight containers. Make sure that there are no crumbs or spills inside cabinets, drawers or the refrigerator.
- 3. Dirty dishes and other food items should not be left in the living room, bedrooms, or other areas of the apartment.
- 4. Clear Clutter: Thoroughly remove clutter from all areas of your house, ensuring that nothing is left on the floor. By decluttering, you eliminate potential hiding spots for cockroaches.
- 5. Daily Floor Maintenance: Vacuum or sweep your floors every day, paying special attention to your kitchen, bathroom, and other areas where cockroaches are commonly found. Utilize vacuum attachments to clean along baseboards and underneath and around furniture.
- 6. Cleaning Hard Surfaces: Thoroughly scrub hard surfaces such as countertops, cabinets, tables, chairs, and other furniture. Pay close attention to corners, seams, and crevices where cockroaches may seek refuge.
